Notes;

When Dorchester was annexed to Boston on Jan. 3, 1870, Fire boxes were numbered in the 300 series.

On March 26, 1891, the first numbers in the 900 series were assigned to fire boxes in Dorchester.

On April 2, 1892, there was a general renumbering of boxes in Dorchester, and some numbers in the 300 series were changed to numbers in the 900 series.

At the same time, some 300 series numbers were changed to numbers in the high 100 series which were also used in South Boston.

In 1914, a new four digit number system was introduced. Numbers in the 3100 and 3200 series were assigned to boxes in Dorchester.

Beginning on Feb. 16, 1956, a general renumbering of boxes in North Dorchester took place. A new 1800 number series was established and these numbers replaced the 3100 and 3200 numbers which were assigned to boxes in other sections of Dorchester.
